Senate Amendment

On page 7, lines 15-17, delete those lines

and insert: to s. 743.015, or similar statutes of other states;

4. Notice is waived if the minor declares in a written or oral statement that she is a victim of child abuse or neglect, or sexual abuse by one or both of her parents, her guardian, or her custodian, or of neglect, abuse or domestic violence under s. 741.28 against herself or any of her family members by another family or household member as defined in s. 741.28. The doctor must record the statement in the patient's medical record. Any physician relying in good faith on a written or oral statement under this subsection shall not be liable for disciplinary action under this subsection for failure to give notice; or

5. Notice is waived under the provisions of subsection (5).
