**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 6, line 31, delete that line

and insert:

(b) The referring physician may not provide the notification required under this section until at least 72 hours after the physician has informed the minor of the notification requirements of this section and given the minor a written statement of the circumstances under which notification may be waived including the process necessary for judicial waiver of notice under subsection (5). The written statement must include the telephone numbers of the Florida Bar Attorney Referral Service and the Court Administrator's Office for the county in which the minor resides. The requirements of this subsection may be waived by the minor signing a written statement that she has no objection to the physician complying immediately with the notification requirements of this section.

(c) Notice shall not be required if:
