Section 287.093, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 21 22 287.093 Minority business enterprises; procurement of personal property and services from funds set aside for such 23 24 purpose. --25 (1) Any county, municipality, community college, or 26 district school board may set aside up to 10 percent or more 27 of the total amount of funds allocated for the procurement of 28 personal property and services for the purpose of entering into contracts with minority business enterprises. 29 30 contracts shall be competitively bid only among minority business enterprises. The set-aside shall be used to redress

present effects of past discriminatory practices and shall be subject to periodic reassessment to account for changing needs and circumstances.
