When, upon the approach of such emergency vehicle, such vehicle gives due warning of its approach to such crossing by the sounding of sirens, flashing of lights, waving of flag, or any other warning sufficient to attract attention to such emergency vehicle; and thereupon the said train or equipment shall be cut and said crossing shall be cleared with all possible dispatch to permit the crossing and passing through of said emergency vehicle. In addition to the provisions of this section, it is unlawful for any railroad corporation to permit any train, railroad car, or engine to obstruct public travel at a railroad-highway grade crossing for a period of more than 5 minutes, except if such train, railroad car, or engine cannot be moved by reason of circumstances over which the railroad corporation has no control.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 1997.

Prohibits a train, railroad car, or engine from blocking a railroad-highway grade crossing for more than 5

minutes.
