Subsection (16) is added to section 13 14 446.609, Florida Statutes, to read: 446.609 Jobs for Florida's Graduates.--15 (16) CONFIDENTIALITY. -- All records of the foundation 16 17 constitute public records and shall be open to the public in accordance with s. 119.07(1), except that the records of 18 19 applicants to and clients of the program which are otherwise 20 confidential shall remain confidential, and except that the identity of a donor who desires to remain anonymous is 21 confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I 22 23 of the State Constitution. The anonymity of such donors shall be maintained in the auditor's report required by subsection 24 (12). This subsection is subject to the Open Government 25 26 Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance with s. 119.15, and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2003, unless reviewed and 27 28 saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature. 29 Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity that the identities of donors to the Florida 30 31 Endowment Foundation for Florida's Graduates be held

confidential and exempt from the public records law. Release of such information could make donors the target of numerous unwanted solicitations and seriously undermine the marketing strategies and fundraising efforts of the foundation.

Section 3. This act shall take effect on the same date as House Bill 1901 or similar legislation creating s. 446.609, Florida Statutes, the Jobs for Florida's Graduates Act, takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof.
