F. To provide for and regulate and control the
furnishing of water, gas, electric, telephone, and other
public utility services within said district, including the
franchising and taxing of such services.

7 To acquire in the name of the district by purchase, 4. gift, or the exercise of the right of eminent domain, such 8 9 lands and rights and interest therein, including lands under water and riparian rights and to acquire such personal 10 property as it may deem necessary in connection with the 11 furnishing of services authorized by this law and to hold and 12 13 dispose of all real and personal property under its control; provided, however, nothing herein contained shall authorize 14 15 the power of eminent domain to be exercised beyond the limits of the district. 16

6. To join with any other district or districts, cities, towns, counties, or other political subdivisions, public agencies or authorities in the exercise of common powers.+

25 7. To levy a special ad valorem maintenance tax upon 26 all taxable real and personal property within said district 27 not to exceed three (3) mills during any one year. Such 28 special maintenance tax shall be levied and collected in the 29 manner provided for the levy and collection of county ad 30 valorem taxes. The district board shall certify each year to 31 the tax collectors of Marion county and Levy county,

respectively, the millage levied as such special maintenance 1 tax and said tax assessors shall be ex-officio tax assessors 2 for the district, and such taxes shall be levied and collected 3 in the same manner as other general county taxes. Taxes 4 5 collected shall be remitted by said tax assessors to the clerk of the circuit court for Marion county, Florida, as ex-officio 6 7 clerk and treasurer of said district. (8) To levy and assess special assessments to fund 8 municipal services within said district. The district board 9 10 shall certify each year to the tax collectors of Marion County and Levy County, respectively, a non-ad valorem assessment 11 roll, and said tax collectors shall be ex officio tax 12 13 collectors for the district, and such special assessments shall be levied and collected pursuant to general law. 14 15 Special assessments collected shall be remitted by said tax collectors to the clerk of the circuit court for Marion County 16 as ex officio clerk and treasurer of said district. 17 Section 2.
