An act relating to vessels; establishing
legislative intent relating to a review of
marine vessel sales and protection of
consumers; requiring Attorney General to
conduct workshops and report results to the
Legislature; establishing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Legislative Intent.--The Legislature recognizes that the purchase of a boat or other water-borne vessel is a major consumer purchase and that a defective boat or other water-borne vessel creates a hardship for the consumer. The Legislature recognizes that a review of such considerations as industry practices, existing regulations, the extent of consumer abuse and other unfair trade practices if any, and fiscal impact is necessary in order to insure the adoption of a cost-effective system that will benefit the citizens of this state.

Section 2. Workshops.

- (1) The Attorney General shall conduct a series of workshops that shall include broad representation from the marine manufacturing industry, vessel sales and service industry (dealers) and consumers. The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services and the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles shall appoint representation to the workshops.
- (2) By March 1, 1999, the Attorney General shall report to the Legislature the findings and recommendations resulting from these workshops.
