A bill to be entitled
An act relating to student discipline; amending
s. 230.23015, F.S.; revising provisions
relating to discipline of students who have
committed an assault or battery on specified
employees; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 230.23015, Florida Statutes, 1996
Supplement, is amended to read:

230.23015 Students violating s. 784.081; ~~expulsion and
placement in alternative school setting.~~--Notwithstanding any
other provision of law, each district school board shall adopt
rules providing that any student found to have committed a
violation of s. 784.081 shall be expelled ~~and placed in an
alternative school setting for a minimum period of 1 year.~~
Upon being charged with the offense, the student shall be
removed from the classroom immediately and placed in an
alternative school setting pending disposition.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1997.

HOUSE SUMMARY

Deletes provisions which require students expelled for
committing an assault or battery on specified employees
to be placed in an alternative school setting for at
least 1 year.
