I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Camp Blanding Management Trust Fund without modification. The Camp Blanding Management Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Military Affairs.

There is no statutory authority for this trust fund.

The re-creation of the Camp Blanding Management Trust Fund would provide funds for the management and maintenance of the Camp Blanding Campsite.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major sources of revenues for the Camp Blanding Management Trust Fund comes from timber sales, mining operations, and billeting.
