I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the State Employees' Child Care Revolving Trust Fund without modification. The State Employees' Child Care Revolving Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Management Services.

Section 110.151, F.S. creates the trust fund, provides purpose and revenue sources.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The re-creation of the State Employees' Child Care Revolving Trust Fund would provide funds for child care services for state officers' and employees' children.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The sole funding source for the State Employee Child Care Revolving Trust Fund is state funds appropriated for maintenance of the state's facilities. Operational funds are paid by participating parents to the contracted providers operating the facilities.
