I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Communications Working Capital Trust Fund without modification. The Communications Working Capital Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Management Services..

Section 216.292, F.S. creates the trust fund, provides purpose and revenue sources

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The re-creation of the Communications Working Capital Trust Fund would provide funds for services provided by the state communications system within the Department of Management Service's Division of Communications.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The primary source of funds for the Communications Working Capital Trust Fund is revenues from operations of the state communications system (SUNCOM).

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
