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I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Supervision Trust Fund without modification. The Supervision Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Management Services.

II. SUBSTANTIVE RESEARCHS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 255.503, F.S. creates the trust fund, provides purpose and revenue sources.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The re-creation of the Supervision Trust Fund would provide funds for the operation of both the Division of Facilities Management and the Division of Capitol Police within the Department of Management Services.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The primary source of funding for the Supervision Trust Fund is from rental payments from buildings in the Department of Management Services rental pool.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.

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III. FISCAL RESEARCH & ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT:

This legislation has no fiscal impact on state agencies or state funds, on local governments as a whole or on the private sector. It simply re-creates, without modification, an existing state trust fund and continues the current use of the fund.
