and insert: 1989, he or she graduated from a school of veterinary medicine listed in the American Veterinary Medical Association Roster of Colleges of the World; and

3. Successfully completed a course of 250 hours in veterinary science offered on October 8, 1997, by the Cuban Veterinary Medical Association in Exile, in conjunction with the Florida International Medical Association and Dade County public schools, which included a competency-based examination and the granting of licenses to persons passing the examination. The Cuban Veterinary Medical Association in Exile must submit to the board a certified list of applicants who have successfully completed the course; or
