Section 13. Subsection (9) is added to section 489.537, Florida Statutes, to read:

489.537 Application of this part.--

(9) Persons licensed under this part are subject to ss. 205.0535(1) and 205.065, as applicable.

Section 14. Subsection (1) of section 205.0535, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

205.0535 Reclassification and rate structure revisions.--

(1) By October 1, 1995, any municipality or county may, by ordinance, reclassify businesses, professions, and occupations and may establish new rate structures, if the conditions specified in subsections (2) and (3) are met. A person who is engaged in the business of providing local exchange telephone service or a pay telephone service in a

 2 pays the occupational license tax under the category
