This act shall take effect upon becoming a 13 14 law. 15 16 17 SENATE SUMMARY Provides that a reasonable towing fee for towing a stolen vehicle at the request of a law enforcement agency may not exceed \$45 for the first mile and \$2 per mile for each additional mile. Provides that a reasonable storage fee for storing a stolen vehicle at the request of a law enforcement agency may not exceed \$5 per day, and no fee may be charged until after the 14th day of storage.
