The standards must apply, without limitation, to 19 language arts, mathematics, science, social studies, the arts, health and physical education, and foreign language, reading, 20 21 writing, history, government, geography, economics, and 22 computer literacy. The commissioner shall obtain opinions and 23 advice from citizens, educators, and members of the business community in developing the standards. For purposes of this 24 25 section, the term "student performance standard" means a 26 statement describing a skill or competency students are 27 expected to learn. 28 Section 2.
