insert:

Section 3. Section 810.14, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

810.14 Voyeurism prohibited; penalties.--

(1) A person commits the offense of voyeurism when he or she, with lewd, lascivious, or indecent intent, secretly observes, photographs, films, videotapes, or records another person when such other person is located in a dwelling, structure, or conveyance and such location provides a reasonable expectation of privacy.

(2) A person who violates this section commits a misdemeanor of the first degree for the first violation, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.

(3) A person who violates this section and who has been previously convicted or adjudicated delinquent two or

1 more times of any violation of this section commits a felony
2 of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s.
3 775.083, or s. 775.084.

4 (4) For purposes of this section, a person has been
5 previously convicted or adjudicated delinquent of a violation

7 sentenced separately, or an adjudication of delinquency
8 entered separately, prior to the current offense.
