Subsections (14) and (15) of section 11 365.171, Florida Statutes, are amended to read: 12 365.171 Emergency telephone number "911."--13 (14) INDEMNIFICATION AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY.--All 14 local governments are authorized to undertake to indemnify the 15 telephone company against liability in accordance with the 16 17 telephone company's lawfully filed tariffs. 1 address, telephone number, or personal information about, or 2 information which may identify any person requesting emergency 3 service or reporting an emergency by accessing an emergency telephone number "911" system is confidential and exempt from 4 5 the provisions of s. 119.07(1), except that such record or б information may be disclosed to a public safety agency. The 7 exemption applies only to the name, address, telephone number 8 or personal information about, or information which may 9 identify any person requesting emergency services or reporting 10 an emergency while such information is in the custody of the 11 public agency or public safety agency providing emergency services. A telephone company or commercial mobile radio 12 service provider shall not be liable for damages to any person 13 14 resulting from or in connection with such telephone company's or commercial mobile radio service provider's provision of any 15 lawful assistance to any investigative or law enforcement 16 17 officer of the State of Florida or political subdivisions thereof, of the United States, or of any other state or 18 19 political subdivision thereof, in connection with any lawful 20 investigation or other law enforcement activity by such law 21 enforcement officer unless the telephone company or commercial mobile radio service provider acted in a wanton and willful 22 manner. The exemptions in this section are subject to the Open 23 24 Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2001, unless 25 reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the 26 Legislature. 27 28 Section 2.
