14	On page 5, lines 13-22, delete those lines

16	and insert:		
17	(1) <u>From the funds appropriated in Specific</u>		
18	<u>Appropriations 361, Grants and Aid - Community Substance Abuse</u>		
19	<u>Services, and 1892, Grants and Aid - WAGES Coalitions, the</u>		
20	<u>Department of Children and Family Services and the WAGES</u>		
21	<u>Program State Board of Directors, in consultation with the</u>		
22	<u>Department of Labor and Employment Security, shall provide a</u>		
23	<u>substance-abuse-treatment program for a person who fails a</u>		
24	<u>drug test conducted under this act and is eligible to receive</u>		
25	<u>temporary assistance or services under the WAGES Program. The</u>		
26	<u>Department of Children and Family Services shall provide for a</u>		
27	<u>retest at the end of the treatment period. Failure to pass the</u>		
28	<u>retest will result in the termination of temporary assistance</u>		
29	<u>or services provided under chapter 414, Florida Statutes, and</u>		
30	<u>of any right to appeal the termination. Implementation of this</u>		
31	<u>project is subject to the availability of funding.</u>
