Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section 11 12 403.1651, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 403.1651 Ecosystem Management and Restoration Trust 13 14 Fund.--The trust fund shall be used for the deposit of 15 (2) 16 all moneys recovered by the state: 17 (a) As a result of actions against any person for a violation of chapter 373 or this chapter initiated by the 18 19 department. No settlement entered into by the department 20 shall limit the Legislature's authority to appropriate moneys 21 from the trust fund; provided, however, that the department 22 may enter into a settlement in which the department agrees to 23 request that moneys received pursuant to the settlement will be included in its legislative budget request for purposes set 24 25 out in the settlement. However, the department shall establish a pilot program for fiscal year 1998-1999 and fiscal year 26 1999-2000 in which the department may enter into settlement 27 28 agreements that require responsible parties to pay civil penalties directly to another government entity or nonprofit 29 30 organization to fund projects that are consistent with the purposes of the Ecosystem Management and Restoration Trust

Fund. The amount paid directly to all government entities or nonprofit organizations during fiscal year 1998-1999 and fiscal year 1999-2000 may not cumulatively exceed \$50,000 per annum. The department shall prepare a report on the efficacy of the pilot program to be presented to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by June 30, 1999, and June 30, 2000. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. \*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\* SENATE SUMMARY Requires the Department of Environmental Protection to establish a pilot program to have civil penalties paid directly to government entities and nonprofit organizations to fund projects that are consistent with the purposes of the Ecosystem Management and Restoration Trust Fund.
