Paragraph (n) of subsection (5) of section 489.127, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 18 19 489.127 Prohibitions; penalties.--20 (5) Each county or municipality may, at its option, 21 designate one or more of its code enforcement officers, as 22 defined in chapter 162, to enforce, as set out in this subsection, the provisions of subsection (1) and s. 489.132(1) 23 against persons who engage in activity for which a county or 24 25 municipal certificate of competency or license or state 26 certification or registration is required. 27 (n) Nothing contained in This subsection does not 28 shall prohibit a county or municipality from enforcing its 29 codes or ordinances by any other means.
