Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The Children's Medical Services facility presently under construction at 5192 Bayou Boulevard in the City of Pensacola, Escambia County, is hereby designated as the "Dr. Reed Bell and Dr. John H. Whitcomb Building." Section 2. The Department of Management Services is authorized and directed to erect appropriate markers designating the "Dr. Reed Bell and Dr. John H. Whitcomb Building." Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
