22	any juvenile assignment center created under this section		
23	shall be converted to a high-level or maximum-level		
24	residential commitment program, subject to availability of		
25	funds.		
26	<u>(7) The department may utilize juvenile assignment</u>		
27	<u>centers to the fullest extent possible for the purpose of</u>		
28	<u>conducting pre-adjudicatory assessments and evaluations of</u>		
29	<u>youth referred to the department. Prior to July 1, 1999, the</u>		
30	<u>department must transition any assignment centers to provide</u>		
31	<u>the capacity necessary to perform the intake and assessment</u>
