The Transportation Disadvantaged Trust Fund 26 within the Department of Transportation, SAMAS number 552731, 27 which was created by section 427.0159, Florida Statutes, and 28 which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 2000, is 29 30 re-created. 31

Section 2. All current balances of the Transportation Disadvantaged Trust Fund within the Department of Transportation are carried forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund are continued. Section 3. This act shall take effect November 4, 2000. HOUSE SUMMARY Re-creates the Transportation Disadvantaged Trust Fund within the Department of Transportation, without modification, and carries forward its current balances and continues its current sources and uses.
