The Fuel Tax Collection Trust Fund within 27 the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, SAMAS 28 number 762319, which was created by section 206.875, Florida 29 Statutes, and which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 30 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 2000, is re-created. 31
