The License Tax Collection Trust Fund 27 within the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, 28 SAMAS number 762452, which was created by section 320.081, 29 Florida Statutes, and which is to be terminated pursuant to 30 Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 2000, is re-created. 31 1

Section 2. All current balances of the License Tax Collection Trust Fund within the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles are carried forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund are continued. Section 3. This act shall take effect November 4, 2000. HOUSE SUMMARY Re-creates the License Tax Collection Trust Fund within the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, without modification, and carries forward its current balances and continues its current sources and uses.
