The Florida Crime Prevention Training 27 Institute Revolving Trust Fund within the Department of Legal 28 Affairs, which was created by section 16.54, Florida Statutes, and which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), 29 30 Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 2000, is 31 hereby re-created.

Section 2. All current balances of the Florida Crime Prevention Training Institute Revolving Trust Fund are hereby carried forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund are hereby continued. Section 3. This act shall take effect November 4, 2000. SENATE SUMMARY Re-creates, without modification, the Florida Crime Prevention Training Institute Revolving Trust Fund within the Department of Legal Affairs and carries forward its current balances and continues its current sources and uses.
