This legislation recreates the Legal Affairs Trust Fund without modification. The Legal Affairs Revolving Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Legal Affairs.

This bill substantially affects section 16.53, of the Florida Statutes.

The receipts of the Legal Affairs Revolving Trust Fund are expended for the investigation, prosecution, and enforcement of the Racketeering Influenced and Corrupted Organizations Act, the Florida Deceptive and Unfair Trade Practices Act, and state or federal antitrust laws. The 1998-1999 fiscal year appropriation is \$5,029,381.
