I. Summary:

This legislation recreates the Operating Trust Fund without modification. The Operating Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Corrections.

This bill affects section 339.08 of the Florida Statutes

II. Present Situation:

The Operating Trust Fund was established to account for the contractual arrangement between the Department of Transportation and the Department of Corrections for specific road maintenance functions performed by prison inmates under the supervision of Department of Corrections personnel with technical assistance provided by the Department of Transportation. The Legislature appropriated \$14,841,822 for fiscal year 1998-1999 from the Operating Trust Fund in the Department of Corrections.

The sources of revenues for the Operating Trust Fund are from the Department of Transportation's State Transportation Trust Fund.

This bill recreates the trust fund without modification.
