The Child Support Trust Fund, which was 22 created within the Office of the State Attorney for the 11th Judicial Circuit and which is to be terminated pursuant to 23 Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on 24 25 November 4, 2000, is hereby re-created. 26 Section 2. All current balances of the Child Support 27 Trust Fund are carried forward, and all current sources and 28 uses of the trust fund are continued. 29 Section 3. This act shall take effect November 4, 30 2000. 31
