This legislation recreates the State Attorney's Forfeiture an Investigative Trust Fund without modification. The State Attorney's Forfeiture and Investigative Trust Fund is administered by the Justice Administration Commission.

This bill re-creates sections of the Florida Statutes.

The Legislative hereby recreates the Forfeiture and Investigative Trust Fund which will appropriate \$487,946. These funds will be divided proportionally to all State Attorney's Offices under the Justice Administration Commission.
