The Indigent Criminal Defense Trust Fund 24 25 within the Justice Administrative Commission, SAMAS number 26 212974, which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), 27 Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 2000, is 28 re-created. 29 Section 2. All current balances of the Indigent Criminal Defense Trust Fund within the Justice Administrative 30

Commission are carried forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund are continued. Section 3. This act shall take effect November 4, 2000.
