38-810A-98 A bill to be entitled 1 2 An act relating to employment by amusement enterprises; requiring an applicant for such 3 4 employment to submit a set of fingerprints to 5 the Department of Agriculture and Consumer 6 Services; requiring the applicant to bear the 7 costs of processing the fingerprints; providing that the work privilege is revocable by the 8 9 department; providing an effective date. 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 11 12 Section 1. Each applicant for employment, including 13 14 those under lease agreement, with any traveling show, exhibition, amusement enterprise, carnival, vaudeville, 15 minstrel, rodeo, theatrical enterprise, game or test of skill, 16 17 riding device, dramatic repertory, or other show or amusement including a concession operating in a tent, enclosure, or 18 19 other temporary structure, whether covered or uncovered) within the grounds of, and in connection with, any public 20 21 fair, exposition, or amusement attraction must file a set of 22 his or her fingerprints with the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services for the purpose of determining any prior 23 criminal record. The department shall submit the fingerprints 24 25 to the Department of Law Enforcement for state processing and forwarding to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for federal 26 27 processing. The applicant shall bear the actual cost of such 28 state and federal processing. The department may allow an applicant to work pending the results of the fingerprint 29 30 investigation, which work privilege is fully revocable if the 31

department subsequently determines that any facts set forth in the application are untrue or misrepresented. Section 2.
