An act relating to alcohol, drug abuse, and
mental health services; providing a process for
achieving equity in the funding of such
services among the service districts of the

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Alcohol, drug abuse, and mental health funding equity; distribution of appropriations.—In recognition of the historical inequity among service districts of the Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services in the funding of alcohol, drug abuse, and mental health services, and in order to rectify this inequity and provide for equitable funding in the future throughout the state, the following funding process shall be adhered to, beginning with the 1997-1998 fiscal year:
- (1) Funding thresholds for alcohol, drug abuse, and mental health services in each of the current districts, statewide, shall be established based on the current number of persons in need per district for alcohol and drug abuse, and for mental health services, respectively.
- (2) Beginning July 1, 1997, 75 percent of any additional funding beyond the 1996-1997 fiscal year base appropriated for alcohol, drug abuse, and mental health services shall be allocated to districts using the statewide needs assessment and allocation methodology used in the development of the Department of Children and Family Services's strategic plan each fiscal year. Allocation amounts

shall be based on the pro-rata share of the amount needed to move all districts toward equity without reducing the base funding for any district. The remaining 25 percent shall be allocated based on the number of persons in need of alcohol, drug abuse, and mental health services per district without regard to current funding levels. Section 2.
