In addition, a copy of each report 19 for candidates for other than statewide office who qualify with the Department of State shall be furnished to filed with 20 the supervisor of elections in each the county any portion of 21 which is within the jurisdiction of the office where the 22 23 candidate seeks resides. Reports to the Department of State shall be filed not later than 5 p.m. of the day designated; 24 however, any report postmarked by the United States Postal 25 26 Service no later than midnight of the day designated shall be 27 deemed to have been filed in a timely manner. A certificate of mailing obtained from and dated by the United States Postal 28 29 Service at the time of mailing, or a receipt from an established courier company, which bears a date on or before 30 the date on which the report is due, shall be proof of mailing 31

in a timely manner. Reports shall contain information of all previously unreported contributions received and expenditures made as of the preceding Friday, except that the report filed on the Friday immediately preceding the election shall contain information of all previously unreported contributions received and expenditures made as of the day preceding that designated due date. All such reports shall be open to public inspection.

Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1 of the year after the year in which enacted.
