A bill to be entitled An act relating to federal designations for Florida land or water bodies; restricting authority to apply for federal designations to the Legislature and the Cabinet; providing an effective date. Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: The Legislature and the Cabinet are the Section 1. only entities authorized to apply for a federal designation for any land or water body in the state, including any lake, river, spring, stream, tributary, aquifer, or watershed. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. HOUSE SUMMARY Provides that the Florida Legislature and the Florida Cabinet are the only entities authorized to apply for a federal designation for any Florida land or water body.
