235.31 Advertising and awarding contracts; prequalification of contractor.--

(2) Boards shall prequalify bidders for construction contracts according to may elect to come under the rules prescribed by the Commissioner of Education which require for the prequalification of bidders of educational facilities construction. Boards shall require that all construction or capital improvement bids be accompanied by evidence that the bidder holds an appropriate certificate or license or that the prime contractor has a current valid license prior to bid award for each project.
