15	WHEREAS, Ben G. Watts dedicated 23 years of his life to
16	public service with the Florida Department of Transportation,
17	and
18	WHEREAS, Ben G. Watts served a vital role in
19	development of Central Florida's transportation planning and
20	funding from 1984 to 1989, first as Director of Production and
21	then as District Secretary of the Florida Department of
22	Transportation's District Five, and
23	WHEREAS, Ben G. Watts served from 1989 to 1997 as
24	Secretary of Transportation for the State of Florida, and
25	WHEREAS, Ben G. Watts has been a leader in efforts to
26	address the transportation needs of the State of Florida, and
27	WHEREAS, under the leadership of Ben G. Watts, the
28	State of Florida doubled the annual expenditures on road and
29	bridge improvements while maintaining low administrative costs
30	and high efficiency in Department of Transportation
