A bill to be entitled An act relating to parole; creating s. 947.182, F.S.; providing definitions; requiring as a condition of the parole of a sex offender or a murderer that the offender apply to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles for a special identification card or driver's license and, if subject to motor vehicle registration requirements, a special color-coded license tag; requiring the department in cooperation with the Department of Law Enforcement to provide for special designation of a sex offender or murderer on any driver's license, identification card, or license tag issued to the paroled offender; amending s. 775.21(7), F.S.; conforming provision relating to determination of the feasibility of requiring sexual predators to have a special designation on any identification card, driver's license, or license tag issued in the state; providing an effective date. Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: Section 1. Section 947.182, Florida Statutes, is created to read: 947.182 Special identification card, driver's license, or license tag as condition of parole for a sex offender or murderer.--

(1) As used in this section, the term:

1 (a) "Convicted" means the person has been determined
2 guilty as a result of a plea or a trial, regardless of whether
3 adjudication is withheld.

- (b) "Murderer" means a person who has been convicted of committing, or attempting, soliciting, or conspiring to commit, any of the criminal offenses proscribed in s. 782.04 or analogous offenses in another jurisdiction, or any similar offense committed in this state which has been redesignated from a former statute number to one of those listed in this paragraph.
- (c) "Sex offender" means a person who has been convicted of committing, or attempting, soliciting, or conspiring to commit, any of the criminal offenses proscribed in the following statutes in this state or analogous offenses in another jurisdiction: s. 787.025, chapter 794, s. 796.03, s. 800.04, s. 827.071, s. 847.0133, s. 847.0135, s. 847.0145, or any similar offense committed in this state which has been redesignated from a former statute number to one of those listed in this paragraph.
- (2) The Parole Commission shall require as a condition of parole for any offender who is a sex offender or murderer that:
- (a) The offender, upon being released for placement on parole, shall apply to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles for a special identification card or, if otherwise qualified, a special driver's license, which shall designate the offender as a sex offender or murderer.
- (b) If the offender is subject to registration requirements for any motor vehicle as provided in chapter 320, the offender shall apply to the department for a special

color-coded license tag which shall designate the offender's status as a sex offender or murderer.

- (3) The Department of Highway Safety and Motor

 Vehicles, in cooperation with the Department of Law

 Enforcement, shall issue to an offender who is a sex offender or murderer on parole:
- (a) A special identification card or, if the offender is otherwise qualified, a special driver's license; and
- (b) A special color-coded license tag designating the offender's status as a sex offender or murderer, when the offender registers a motor vehicle.

Section 2. Paragraph (d) of subsection (7) of section 775.21, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

775.21 The Florida Sexual Predators Act; definitions; legislative findings, purpose, and intent; criteria; designation; registration; community and public notification; immunity; penalties.--

- (7) COMMUNITY AND PUBLIC NOTIFICATION. --
- (d) The department shall adopt a protocol to assist law enforcement agencies in their efforts to notify the community and the public of the presence of sexual predators. Notwithstanding s. 947.182, the department, in consultation and cooperation with the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, shall determine the feasibility of requiring sexual predators to have a special designation on any driver's license, identification card, or license tag issued in this state.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
