(b) An inmate or offender in the correctional system or under correctional supervision, whether on parole, probation, postrelease supervision, or any other form of supervision, is prohibited from disclosing or using personal information, about health care clinicians, educational personnel and other state officers or employees whose duties are performed in whole or in part in the state correctional system with intent to obtain a benefit or with intent to harm, harass or defraud state officers, employees and others. Any person who violates this section commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. For the purposes of this subsection, the term "harass" shall be defined as to engage in a course of conduct directed at a specific person that causes substantial
