After the issuance of an assessment, a technical 7 assistance advisement may not be issued to a taxpayer who requests an advisement relating to the tax or liability for 8 9 tax in respect to which the assessment has been made, except 10 that a technical assistance advisement may be issued to a taxpayer who requests an advisement relating to the exemptions 11 12 in s. 212.08(1) or (2) at any time.
