An independent environmental impact study shall be undertaken and a report with recommendations 16 17 shall be submitted to the President of the Senate and the 18 Speaker of the House of Representatives by January 1, 1999. When the report is submitted to the Legislature, the ban may 19 20 be removed if appropriate. 21 Section 2.
