Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (5) of section 526.141, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

526.141 Self-service gasoline stations; attendants; regulations.--

(5)(a) Every full-service gasoline station offering self-service at a lesser cost shall require an attendant employed by the station to dispense gasoline from the self-service portion of the station to any motor vehicle properly displaying an exemption parking permit as provided in s. 316.1958 or s. 320.0848 or a license plate issued pursuant to s. 320.084, s. 320.0842, s. 320.0843, or s. 320.0845 when the person to whom such permit has been issued is the operator of the vehicle and such service is requested. Such stations shall prominently display a decal no larger than 8 square inches on the front of all self-service pumps clearly stating the requirements of this subsection and the penalties applicable to violations of this subsection. Such stations shall prominently display, on or directly adjacent to each

gasoline pump that is used to provide requested services to 1 the operator of any motor vehicle properly displaying an 2 3 exemption permit or license plate specified in this paragraph, a plastic sign which shall identify the gasoline pump or pumps 4 5 at which an attendant will dispense gasoline to such motor 6 vehicles pursuant to the requirements of this subsection. 7 Each sign shall be clearly visible to occupants of passing 8 vehicular traffic on roadways contiguous to the station, shall 9 be made of plastic, with dimensions of no less than 8 inches 10 in width and 10 inches in height, and shall feature the international symbol of accessibility as the central image of 11 the sign, with an image of a gas pump handle displayed to the 12 13 right of the symbol of accessibility. The international symbol of accessibility, gas pump image, and border of each 14 15 sign shall be painted with white, light-reflective paint, and each sign shall have a blue background. The Department of 16 17 Agriculture and Consumer Services shall enforce these 18 requirements this requirement.

- (b) Violation of paragraph (a) is a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
- (7) The Insurance Commissioner, under her or his powers, duties, and functions as State Fire Marshal, shall promulgate rules and regulations for the administration and enforcement of this section, except for subsection (5) which shall be administered and enforced by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.
