In 18 addition, an no elected public official is not eligible for 19 service on a grand jury. 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1 of the 21 year in which enacted. 22 23 24 LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY Provides that a grand jury may consist of a maximum of 21 persons rather than a maximum of 18 persons.
