Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 914.25, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

914.25 Protective services for certain victims and 15 witnesses.--

(1) For purposes of this section:

providing an effective date.

- (a) A "victim or witness at risk of harm" means a victim or witness who, as a result of cooperating in an investigation or prosecution of a serious felony offense, has been subjected to violence or other forms of intimidation, or who is the subject of a substantial threat to commit violence. The term also includes a member of the victim's or witness's immediate family.
- (b) "Serious felony offense" means one of the following offenses, and includes a criminal attempt, criminal solicitation, or criminal conspiracy to commit any of the following offenses: murder, manslaughter, sexual battery, aggravated stalking, aggravated battery, carjacking, home invasion robbery, burglary, arson, robbery, kidnapping, racketeering, or trafficking in a controlled substance.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1 of the year in which enacted. HOUSE SUMMARY Redefines "serious felony offense" with respect to specified provisions relating to protective services for certain victims and witnesses to include criminal attempts, solicitations, or conspiracies to commit certain offenses.
