Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 4, between lines 15 and 16,

insert:

Section 2. Effective upon this act becoming a law, subsection (9) of section 336.025, Florida Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (10) and a new subsection (9) is added to said section to read:

336.025 County transportation system; levy of local option fuel tax on motor fuel and diesel fuel.--

(9) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, the governing board of a charter county that has a population of 1,250,000 or more persons and which levied a 3-cent tax under paragraph (1)(b) prior to January 1, 1998, may use the proceeds of 1 cent of that 3-cent tax in any fiscal year to fund any homeless assistance program within the county. The charter county may establish an interlocal agreement with one or more municipalities located within the county, representing a majority of the population of the
