2. At least 50 percent of the traffic using the road segment passes directly through the local government's jurisdiction. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. б HOUSE SUMMARY Provides that, at the request of local government, the Department of Transportation shall lower the level-of-service standard one letter grade on any segment of the Florida Interstate Highway System that is within the requesting local government's jurisdiction under described circumstances.
