A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the East County Water Control District, Lee and Hendry counties; amending chapter 87-477, Laws of Florida, as amended; providing for a change in the date of election of members of the district board of supervisors for each seat to conform with the state general election cycle; providing for extension of terms of the current members of the district board of supervisors; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 1 of chapter 87-477, Laws of Florida, as amended by chapters 90-393 and 93-309, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:

Section 1. The provisions of chapter 298, Florida Statutes, and chapter 63-1549, Laws of Florida, as amended, to the contrary notwithstanding, the following provisions, to the extent of any conflict, shall control the East County Water Control District:

(3) Thereafter, all district supervisor elections shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of <u>even-numbered</u> odd-numbered years. All district supervisors shall be elected at large by nonpartisan plurality vote with the candidate who receives the highest number of votes for each seat winning the election. Only registered voters residing within the district shall be permitted to vote. The costs of any election shall be borne by the

district. Terms of all supervisors shall begin on the day after the election as established by this act. Section 2. The terms of the supervisors of the Board of Supervisors of the East County Water Control District serving on the effective date of this act shall each be extended for 1 year to the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of the even-numbered year following the year in which their term is currently due to expire. Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
