I. FINAL ACTION STATUS:

HB 3459 passed the House on April 23, 1998; in the Senate was substituted for SB 2380 and passed on May 1, 1998. Became law without Governor's signature on May 27, 1998. Chapter Law 98-236.

This legislation re-creates the Law Enforcement Trust Fund without modification. The Law Enforcement Trust Fund is administered by Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles.
