II. Summary of Amendments Contained in Message

1 to Senate Amendment 553366 This amendment provides that the changes made by HB 3509 to requirements for a specialty license plate or a motor vehicle or driver's license voluntary contribution established in this bill will not apply to any organization which has requested and received an application for a specialty license plate, has opened a bank account for the fee and accepted deposits, and has obtained signatures toward completing the requirements for the specialty tag. The amendment then states that all applications requested on or after the effective date of this act will be covered by the provisions of the act.

The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles will request information from applicants to determine compliance with this provision.

In addition to waiving the application requirements in the bill, the amendment relieves the applicant of the amended audit requirements in the bill and the provisions for eliminating a tag which does not sell significant numbers of tags.
